Batting Cage Rules and Regulations

- Appropriate behavior is required at all times. Failure to follow regulations may lead to removal from the facility
- All new users will be required to complete a brief orientation before operating the pitching machine
- All batters are <u>required</u> to provide and wear a helmet while in the batting cage
- Batters must provide their own feeders for the pitching machine
- Youths under 15 must be accompanied by an adult
- No food or drink is allowed in the batting cage
- All users are expected to keep the batting cages clean and free of litter at all times
- While the cage is in use, the access must be closed to prevent outside observers from being exposed to hit balls
- All pitchers/pitching machine operators are <u>required</u> to use the protective screen at all times of operation
- Only two people will be in the cage at one time: the batter and pitcher/pitching machine operator/catcher
- Youths under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult. Adults are responsible for the actions of the youths in the batting cage
- Absolutely NO CLEATS are allowed inside the batting cage. All users are required to wear closed-toed shoes while in the batting cage
- All bat swinging, even practice swings, must take place INSIDE the batting cage
- Please take practice pitches without the batter in the cage until desired speed and location is achieved. No adjustments should be made with the batter in the cage
- When finished, please return balls to the buckets
